# **SAFETY**

#### ATTIRE

Use non slip footwear and bring a towel for wet conditions to dry your disc before each throw



Wear clothing that is **comfortable**, keeps you warm enough but **doesn't restrict movement** 

### MISC

First check if there are **blind spots** on your fairway, if so, use a player from your card as a "**spotter**" and take turns to throw from the tee

#### when it is safe

# **SAFETY**

#### MISC continued

Make sure everyone on the card is **behind the thrower** and that the fairway ahead is **safe & clear** 



After finishing all **tee shots**, walk together to help find **lost discs**. The next thrower is the person furthest away from the target, taking turns, until the hole is **complete** 

Repeat the same process for **all holes** until the round has ended





# **HOW TO PLAY**

Play as an **individual** or a **group** of no more than roughly **5** people



Decide on an order for hole 1 and take turns teeing off.

On hole 2+, the person who threw the least will drive first, with the rest in order of best score

#### FOR EXAMPLE

Sally gets a **2**, Barry gets a **3** and Wally also gets a **3**. There order of play was **Barry**, **Wally**, **Sally**. On **hole 2**, they will throw in the following order:


Sally, Barry, Wally

# HOW TO PLAY continued

After **everyone** has teed off, each player finds there disc, **marks the lie** and **completes the hole** 



Complete the full course and the person with the fewest throws total is the winner
