Everyone knows that **Defibrillators** can save lives.

Due to the generosity of **Frank Law**, we now have one on the side of **Springfield Community Centre**. It will be available to anyone who uses the Park or Centre. That also includes Bowls, Tennis, Allotments, Day Nursery, Dog Walkers or Visitors.

The Defibrillator at the Con Club has already needed to be used twice!



If you have been to the Centre recently, for the Café, to use the Hall or just for the Toilet, you will have noticed **changes underfoot!**

The crumbling and uneven red bricks can no longer be seen. The crazy paving footpath, that seemed to be designed to be a tripping hazard, is no more. The big, black ramp at the entrance, that could be a challenge, has gone.

Instead, we have a **smooth tarmac surface** with some red decorative stones. Gradients have been sorted and it is much more superior for everyone but especially for those with mobility issues or in a wheelchair.
